ANNUAL REPORT OF SOUTHFIELD COLLEGE 2019-20

The college had just started after the winter break when our Hon'ble Prime Minister called for a Nation wide lockdown due to the outbreak of the Covid-19 Pandemic. The college had already participated in a lot of activities but the sudden lockdown led to complete cessation of all activities in the college.

However, Southfield College was the first college in the Hills to start online classes. The college had already completed one month of online classes when Higher Education Department of West Bengal circulated a Government Order to start online classes. Not only teaching became online, but the examination system became totally online.

In order that the teachers and students did not become slack and idle, many online webinars and online activities were carried out. Even the foundation Day of the college, Yoga Day etc and Orientation of newly admitted students were conducted online.

University Under Graduate Results:

The Under Graduate University results of the outgoing students was excellent as all the students who appeared for the examinations, passed making the pass percentage 100%.

'Adopt a child activity' of the College:

A four year old girl child by the name of Jyoti Tamta of Gairsain village has been adopted by the college to help her in her vaccination, upkeep and studies through Plan International India.

NSS Activities:

Student activities:
