ANNUAL REPORT OF SOUTHFIELD COLLEGE 2022-23

The new session started with the memories of the pandemic fading slowly. The college once again turned on its vibrant mood and the students started participating actively in all the co-curricular and extra-curricular activities of the college.

University Under Graduate Results:

The results of the Final year students were very good as all who appeared, passed, making the pass percentage of students as 100% pass.

University Post Graduate Results:

The final results are yet to come but the semester results of both English and History are very good.

Student Activities:

College Sports Day was organized on 20.10.2022. A total of six tournaments comprising of football, Volleyball, Basketball, Badminton, Table tennis, and carrom were organized by the Sports committee.

The **Divisional Youth Parliament Competition (YPC) 2022-23** was held in Parimal Mitra Smriti Mahavidyalaya, Mal Bazar, Jalpaiguri on 12.11.2022. Southfield College bagged the prize for the first Runners up in the YPC. Ms Nandika Pradhan received the Prize for the Best 'Leader of Opposition. The college was selected for the state level competition to be held in Kolkata.

On 21.02.2023 the college observed **International Mother Language Day**.

The **Avante Garde** fest was organized by Cultural committee for three days from 19.05.2023 to 21.05.2023. The fest involved all kinds of competitions from singing competitions, dancing competitions including painting and photography competitions. The attraction of the fest was fashion show with ethnic wear and casual wear dress competitions.

Co-curricular activities:

On 25.03.2023, as part of the student-faculty exchange program, the Department of English hosted an interactive session with the students from Birpara College, Alipurduar, titled 'Our World, our Words' on Indrabahadur Rai's 'There's a Carnival Today' and other worksof literature dealing with Indian Experience. Incubation Centre:

On 06.06.2023, A training programme on the scope of Floriculture and vermicomposting was jointly organized by Kalimpong Horticulture Society (KHS) and Nature Club of Southfield College at Damien Hall. President of the Horticulture Society Dr. M.Foning gave a presentation on importance of floriculture and vermicomposting for an organic living environment and to encourage entrepreneurship among the students. The team demonstrated before the students the methods and techniques of preparing vermicompost.

College grown Mushrooms and hybrid cymbidium orchids and vermicompost were put on sale by the students as an entrepreneurial initiative.

Alumni Activities:

On 08.06.2023, The Alumni Association of the College organized a charity show and presented a movie 'jeevan kara ki phool' to students of Southfield, various schools and colleges and alumnae members. The Artists of the movie were invited and due respect was given to them.

Complete Automation of Library:

Bar coding of books were initiated and is still continuing. Further, the automation of the Library was completed by the installation of **Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) Technology**. As the Library is open access type of Library, RFID installation was a necessity. Southfield College will be the first college in the Hills to have installed RFID for complete automation of the Library.

ICT Infrastructure:

After signing MOU with Garul and Chandrawati foundation, a computer Lab was established and with their help, computer classes on basics of programming was started. There are total 20 (twenty) computers in Computer Lab 1 and Computer Lab 2 together for the students.

A Geographical Information System(GIS) Laboratory was installed in the Geography Department. As the Geography Department is the oldest Department among the colleges under the University of North Bengal, the University always makes Southfield College the nodal centre for Practical Examinations. As the new syllabus requires GIS laboratory, the GIS lab was started in the College this year.

The college is always making new moves to undertake environment friendly initiatives. To help in the 'Go Green' initiative of the college, a **Digital notice board** was installed in the college to minimize the use of publishing notices on paper.

RUSA Building:

The process of the construction of the RUSA building has started. The PWD of Darjeeling has taken the initiative to inspect the land and has made the building plan duly vetted by the Superintendent Engineer, Jalpaiguri. The e-tendering is on process and the construction will commence after the monsoons. The building will contain Girl's common room and three classrooms.

Girls Hostel Construction:

The Girl's Hostel construction has started inside the college campus. It will be able to board fifty students. The Girls hostel is being constructed by the Gorkhaland Territorial Administration and is estimated to be of 1.63 crores.

'Adopt a child activity' of the College:

A four year old girl child by the name of Jyoti Tamta of Gairsain village who had been adopted by the college to help her in her vaccination, upkeep and studies through Plan International India is successfully going to school. She is now studying in Primary school.

Future plans:

The Administrative has the oldest lift of Darjeeling. It has an old lift which is supposed to be a manual lift. It is not in working order. The college hopes to generate funds for the renovation of the lift so that it can be used by the differently abled students.
