ANNUAL REPORT OF SOUTHFIELD COLLEGE DARJEELING (2023-2024)

The new session 2023-24 started with new enthusiasm with the NAAC 3rd Cycle Accreditation being planned for the month of October 2023. Aside from the preparation for the NAAC Peer team visit the College continued with its usual classes and Annual activities.

University Under Graduate and Post Graduate Results:

The University undergraduate results of the final year students was good with a pass percentage of 86.4%. University Post graduate first Semester results were also good.

Student and Committee Activities:

On 28^{th} of July an interactive program with the parents were conducted for all round development of the students.

On the 11th of August Nehru Yuva Kendra, Ministry of Youth affairs and Sports, Government of India in association with Armeena Foundation and Southfield College Darjeeling organised 'Yuva Sambad- India at 2047" in Damien hall. The main objective of the event was to embrace the 'Panch Pran' by 2047 when the country celebrates 100 years of Independence.

On 11th of August a tree plantation drive was conducted by Nature Club of Southfield College with the help of First semester Environmental Studies students.

The College was reaccredited with 'A' Grade with CGPA 3.10 in third cycle of Reaccreditation. We all are really proud of this and very happy because Southfield College became the only Women's College in North Bengal and under North Bengal University to be awarded with 'A' Grade.

On the 4th and 5th and 7th of November Southfield College organised programs to all stakeholders, students and staff to express gratitude for all their help in achieving 'A' grade in 3rd Cycle of NAAC Reaccreditation.

Placement of outgoing students:

On 10th of July 2023, India's largest airline -Indigo,in collaboration with Emporium training and consultancy Private limited and Career guidance and Placement cell of Southfield college conducted the first campus interview at Southfield college. Out of total 396 female candidates from all over Darjeeling, Kalimpong, Sikkim and Dooars, 16 candidates were selected out of which 7 candidates from our College were selected for the position of Cabin Crew.
